


 Through time: Personal names recorded in documents.



- •845 'the ships at Limerick' (AU, CS)
- •922 Tamar/Tomrar lands at Limerick (CGG)
- •965 Limerick sacked: described as dun with streets and houses (CGG)
- •1290s Siwards own 2 burgages in Limerick (CD)
- •1309 house of Thomas Harold burned in Limerick (CJR)
- •1685 Thomas Philips map shows layout of probable pre-Norman town (Hodkinson 2002)

- •Limerick<Hlymrekr<Luimneach (Greene 1976)
- •Athlunkard<Ath Longphoirt (CS 1656 'Longford')
- •Lax Weir (Lk Corp. Rentbook 1669 'Lax Weir')
- •Rathurd<Rathsyward (BBL 1253 Rathsyward; CJR 1311 Walter Syward of Sywardsrath)
- •Dooradoyle <Tworodell (Down Survey 1654) conjecturally < Thordelb (Westropp 1905)
